#### John Calvin

John Calvin was born in 1509 in France. By the time he started university in Paris, the Protestant Reformation was having a significant impact across Europe. He was forced to flee Paris as the Catholic Church believed Nicolas Cop and John Calvin had been instrumental in coercing people into heresy. Calvin stopped over in Geneva on his way to Strasbourg and was encouraged by William Farrell (a reformer) to stay and work towards reforming the church in this region. While there he wrote many articles and books that still influence Christianity to this day. His most famous works were his 'Institutes of Christian Religion'. Calvin believed it is by the grace of God alone that we can approach a holy God, through the redemptive work of Jesus Christ (Ephesians 2:8-10). He explains that it is not through any of our works that we can attain salvation, but that it is a gift from God alone. As Calvin wrote, "Faith, then, brings a man empty to God, that he may be filled with the blessings of Christ." Some have used the acronym tulip to help understand his theology.
