#### **Welcome to David Spitteler**

David started the Asylum Seekers Centre in Balaclava on February 6, 1997 and then shifted to Dandenong in 2001. The centre is a place for hospitality and welcome. It is an oasis for many people, a safe place for those who have fled situations of great danger. Over the past few years they have helped over 107 families (441 people) with food and support. About 80% of those seeking help are Muslim and about 30% are from Myanmar.
