Updated Covid information

- If you have any of symptoms of Covid do not enter any of our buildings. Symptoms may include one or more of the following: fever, cough, tiredness, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, headache, aches and pains, diarrhoea, a rash on skin or discolouration of fingers or toes, red or irritated eyes, difficulty breathing or shortness of breath, loss of speech, loss of mobility, confusion or chest pain.
