Ash Wednesday Services 2 March 2022

Lent begins on March 2 and it is a time where many fast from something (coffee, chocolate, TV, social media etc.) so that they can spend time examining their lives before God. We start this season with services: St Chad's at 2pm and St Aidan's at 7pm. This day is set apart as a day of repentance and confession, a time of recognition of and sorrow for the wrongs we have committed. Part of the Ash Wednesday service allows those attending the opportunity to come forward to receive the mark of a cross in ash on their forehead. This symbolises the power of Christ's death on the cross to transform sin to salvation and death to life.
