# William Tyndale - Bible Alone

William Tyndale is one of the most significant figures in English history. He gave the nation its first English Bible and in doing so gave the country a unified language. He was born in England and studied theology at Oxford. At university he was horrified that there were no subjects on the Bible as part of his degree, so he formed small reading groups of fellow students to study the Bible in the evenings. Later he made it his life's work to produce a Bible for ethe common man.

William Tyndale could speak seven languages and was proficient in ancient Hebrew and Greek. He was a priest whose intellectual gifts and disciplined life could have taken him a long way in the church—had he not had one compulsion: to teach English men and women the good news of justification by faith.

The Catholic Church in England would not allow the production of his English translation of the Bible, so Tyndale worked in secret in Germany. In 1526 he completed translating the first English New Testament. He started working on the Old Testament but was arrested and imprisoned before completion. After a hear in jail he was sentenced to death and as he died, his final cry encapsulated his unwavering mission to bring the word of God to the people: "Lord open the King of England's eyes."
