

Bible Reading: Jeremiah 15:10-21

¹⁰ Woe is me, my mother, that you ever bore me, a man of strife and contention to the whole land! I have not lent, nor have I borrowed, yet all of them curse me. ¹¹ The LORD said: Surely I have intervened in
