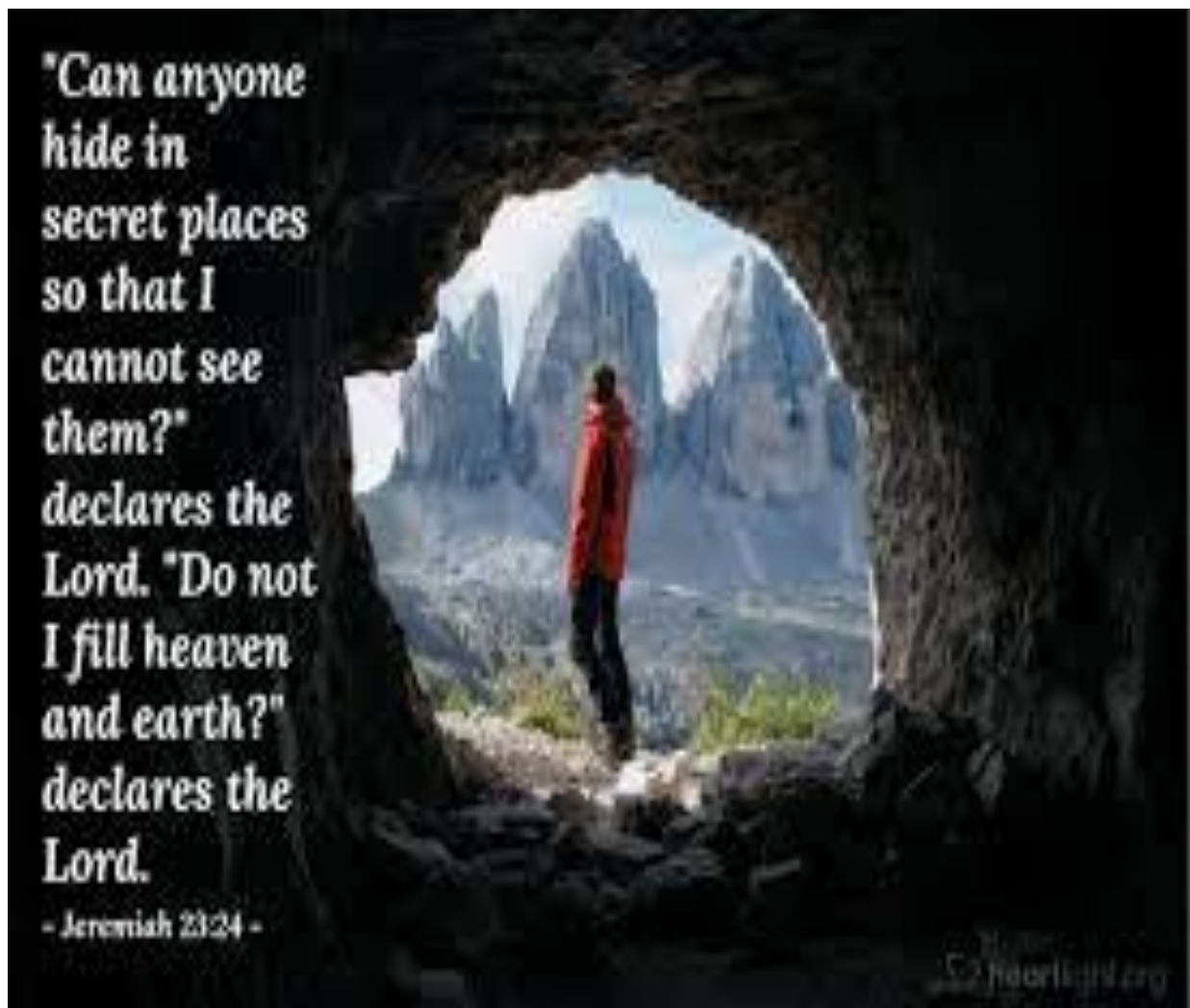

Bible Reading: Jeremiah 23:15-32

Therefore thus says the LORD of hosts concerning the prophets:
I am going to make them eat wormwood
and give them poisoned water to drink,
for from the prophets of Jerusalem
ungodliness has spread throughout the land.

¹⁶ Thus says the LORD of hosts: Do not listen to the words of the prophets who prophesy to you; they are deluding you. They speak visions of their own minds, not from the mouth of the LORD. ¹⁷ They keep saying to those who despise the word of the LORD, "It shall be well with you," and to all who stubbornly follow their own stubborn hearts, they say, "No calamity shall come upon you."

¹⁸ For who has stood in the council of the LORD
so as to see and to hear his word?

¹⁹ Look, the storm of the LORD, Wrath has gone forth,

Will the hearts of the prophets ever turn back—those who prophesy lies and who prophesy the deceit of their own heart? ²⁷ They plan to make my people forget my name by their dreams that they tell one another, just as their ancestors forgot my name for Baal. ²⁸ Let the prophet who has a dream tell the dream, but let the one who has my word speak my word faithfully. What has straw in common with wheat? says the LORD. ²⁹ Is not my word like fire, says the LORD, and like a hammer that breaks a rock in pieces? ³⁰ See, therefore, I am against the prophets, says the LORD, who steal my words from one another. ³¹ See, I am against the prophets, says the LORD, who use

their own tongues and say, "Says the LORD." ³² See, I am against those who prophesy lying dreams, says the LORD, and who tell them and who lead my people astray by their lies and their recklessness, when I did not send them or command them, so they do not profit this people at all, says the LORD.
