Overview of the Book of Jeremiah

Jeremiah lived and prophesied in the sixth century BC in the land of Judah. The Northern Kingdom had been in exile for years and the Southern Kingdom was heading in the same direction because of the ever-worsening religious hypocrisy, economic dishonesty and oppressive practices of Judah's leaders and those who followed them. Jeremiah was the voice of warning, the watchman who brings attention to hard truths that others would rather ignore.

However, Jeremiah's prophecies also resound with the theme that they worship a promise keeping God. When God makes a covenant with the nation of Israel, he will not let that relationship be thwarted, even when his people are faithless. The pledge "I will be your God, and you shall be my people" is the constant promise of God to wayward Israel throughout the book of Jeremiah (7:23; 11:4; 30:22). This is great encouragement to God's people around the world today, for they have become the heirs of God's covenant promises to ethnic Israel. No matter how others identify us socially, ethnically, or racially, believers today can know that, through Christ, the God of the Bible will be our God, and we will be his people.
