Sensible Shoes Study Guide

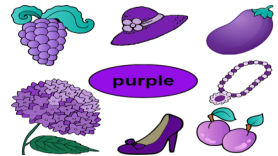
The Sensible Shoes small group started well last Saturday. We have 3 study guides for sale (\$14.50) if you would like to read the book and follow the questions by yourself.
