Who is the Holy Spirit?

Over the next few weeks we will be exploring the person and work of the Holy Spirit and how we can know him better and be used by the Spirit to grow God's Kingdom.

The Holy Spirit is God (Acts 5:3-4) the third person of the Trinity. He possesses the characteristics of God such as omnipresence (being everywhere) - Psalm 139:7-8 and omniscience (all knowing) - 1 Corinthians 2:10 -11. We can know that the Holy Spirit is a divine person because He possesses a mind, emotions, a will and a soul. The Holy Spirit thinks and knows (1 Corinthians 2:10). He makes decisions according to His will (I Corinthians 12:7-11) and intercedes for us and through us (Romans 8:26-27). As God, the Holy Spirit can truly function as the Comforter and Counsellor that Jesus promised He would be (John 14;16, 26, 15:26). The Holy Spirit hears, speaks, teaches, and guides us into truth. He glorifies Christ, reveals Christ to us, and brings all of Christ's words to our remembrance. He shows us the things to come, knows the deep things of God, searches all things, and reveals all things. Where He is, there is liberty. He inspired the writers of the Bible. He reveals the Son to us. We are convicted by Him, born again by Him, led by Him, filled by Him, and

sealed by Him.

We are empowered by him to be God's witnesses in the world (Acts 1:8) and are given fruits (Galatians 5:22) and gifts (1 Corinthians 12:1-11) to grow God's Kingdom. The truth is the Holy Spirit desires a relationship with us and wants us to know him.
