## **Hymn-fest – Sunday 30 October**

Next Sunday, we are having a hymn-fest with lots of music from across the past few centuries. If you have a favourite, then please let Sue know and we will endeavour to use some of these within the service.

The hymn 'Lord Jesus (Living Lord)' reminds us:

- That Christ came to live amongst us (the word became flesh and dwelt amongst us)
- That he died on the cross for us
- He forgave our sin

The author, Patrick Robert Norman Appleford was born in 1925 and only died three years ago. He was an English Anglican priest and hymnwriter. Along with Geoffrey Beaumont and others he was a founder of the "Twentieth Century Church Light Music Group" around 1960, which significantly affected the development of hymn-writing and hymn-singing across English-speaking churches from that time onwards. Music in both the secular and the Church scene changed considerably during the 60's and this hymn brought about some of that transition.

His hymn "Lord Jesus Christ (Living Lord)", for which he wrote both music and text, is found in at least seventeen hymnals worldwide and has been translated into several languages. The music of his "New English Mass" set the emerging modern-language English texts of the Church of England communion service for congregational accessibility, establishing a trend which has been followed by many other composers of liturgical music. The music and some wording is similar to the song that Cliff Richard sang called 'Living Doll'.
