Three Faithful Servants

The writer to the Hebrews in chapter 12 wrote, "Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight and the sin that clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us."

Over the past week, there have been three significant Heroes of the faith who have died. Father Bob was a Catholic priest who was a social justice campaigner and was known as the "people's priest". He wanted nobody to be left behind and always saw and believed in the good in people, but he knew that there were many whom he referred to as the unloved and unlovely. These were his real passion.

John Uren was a Uniting Church Minister who was instrumental in the early years of his ministry had an incredible impact on Churches both in Australia and around the world to take youth work seriously. He also had a heart for social justice and was quite influential politically in taking the issue of the treatment of Asylum Seekers more seriously.

Charles Stanley was an American Baptist Minister who grew his Church significantly through great leadership, his writings and teaching. Many of his sermons were televised and his belief in the inerrancy of scripture came through in all of his teaching.

These three men were faithful servants of the Lord who professed their faith in Jesus Christ, the 'author and perfecter of their faith' (Heb 12:2). They were ministers who were not perfect, but who worked on becoming more Christ like and persevered in obeying God's calling on their life and who patiently endured all things so that they could grow and mature in their faith.
