Building works at Longbeach Anglican Church St Chad's and St Aidan's

We have recently restumped the hall floor at St Chad's and it is now time to lay a new floor. We have been consulting with our builder as to the best surface: we would like to lay a hardy floor that will see us through the next twenty years with minimum maintenance required. We have raised \$16,500 to cover most of the cost of restumping. The flooring will cost a further \$30,000. St Chad's hall is hired out to various groups and the income has been of benefit to our church (this will be in excess of \$25,000 annually). But more than that, it is used weekly for Matt's place and playgroup. It is also used for many other ministry and outreach events including the Passover dinner, holiday program, the fete, the market (in holidays) to name a few.

St Adian's hall also needs some work and we will be relining the storage room, constructing a shelter at the front door of the hall. putting in a sliding door and a few other things to make this a safer place for our Pantry guests.

We would ask that you pray on this matter and consider if contributing to the hall floor refurbishment and St Aidan's hall is something you feel called to do on behalf of our church. If you do decide to contribute, please bank a donation of any amount to our ADF building fund:
