Advent Wreath: Joy

Lighting a candle is a simple yet profound act. It is a testimony to the power of light over darkness. As we light this third candle of Advent, we continue our journey to Christmas. The third candle of Advent is called the **Joy** candle; as we anticipate Christmas, let us remember the **joy** felt by those who realized what was happening.

The Word of the Lord as Prophesied by Jeremiah

I will turn their mourning into gladness; I will give them comfort and **joy** instead of sorrow.

Scripture reminds us that true **joy** comes from trusting in God. Paul wrote in Romans 15:13

May the God of hope fill you with all **joy** and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Jesus Christ is the true answer for hope, peace, and joy in this season and for eternity.

We light this Advent candle, and we pray: Come Lord Jesus! Open our lives to the Joy which you bring; let us turn to you and get ready!
