

3 March 2024 Our mission is to: Shine with the love of Jesus, grow mature disciples and declare the Good News.

Throughout Jesus, time on earth with the disciples, he told them many times, "My time has not yet come", (John 7:6,8) and also said the son of man came to give his life as a ransom for many (Mark 10:45). Jesus did not tell them the exact time of his death.

Over the past few weeks we have been looking at the events of Jesus' final week where he fulfilled his mission to seek and save the lost and ultimately became the atoning sacrifice for humanity - once and for all. Listed below is a timeline of Jesus last week.

Palm Sunday: Commemorates Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. This is the fulfillment of prophecy and the beginning of the end of Jesus' earthly ministry. Bible Verses: <u>Matthew 21:1-11</u>, <u>Mark 11:1-11</u>, <u>Luke 19:28</u>-44, John 12:12-19.

Monday: Jesus' cleansing of the Temple which emphasises the importance of the worship space being a place for worship and holiness. Bible Verses: <u>Matthew 21:12-17</u>, <u>Mark 11:15-19</u>, <u>Luke 19:45-48</u>.

Tuesday: Teaching and parables, including the Olivet Discourse where Jesus prepares his disciples for what is to come. Bible Verses: <u>Matthew</u> 21:23-26:5, <u>Mark 11:20-13</u>:37, <u>Luke 20:1-21</u>:36.

Wednesday (Spy Wednesday): Judas' agreement to betray Jesus. Bible Verses: Matthew 26:14-16, Mark 14:10-11, Luke 22:1-6.

Maundy Thursday: The last supper, the washing of the disciple's feet and the institution of the Lord's Supper. Bible Verses: <u>Matthew 26:17-</u>30, Mark 14:12-26, Luke 22:7-39, John 13:1-17:26.

Good Friday: Crucifixion and death of Jesus. Bible Verses: <u>Matthew 27:1-</u> 61, <u>Mark 15:1-47</u>, <u>Luke 23:1-56</u>, <u>John 18:28-19</u>:42.

Holy Saturday: Jesus' body in the tomb. Bible Verses: <u>Matthew 27:62-66</u>. **Easter Sunday:** Resurrection of Jesus which brings victory over sin and death and forms the foundation of the Christian faith. Bible Verses: <u>Matthew 28:1-10</u>, <u>Mark 16:1-8</u>, <u>Luke 24:1-12</u>, <u>John 20:1-18</u>.

The meal will follow much of the traditional Jewish Passover Meal format but with a reinterpretation of those elements that are now part of the Christian Communion Service. This is a wonderful way of entering into the events that began that first Easter. If you would like to attend this Passover Meal, please register by entering your name on the list in the foyer. Cut off for registrations is Tuesday March 26th. This year, so that members of the congregation don't have to prepare and cook in the kitchen all day, we are having the meal catered for.
