

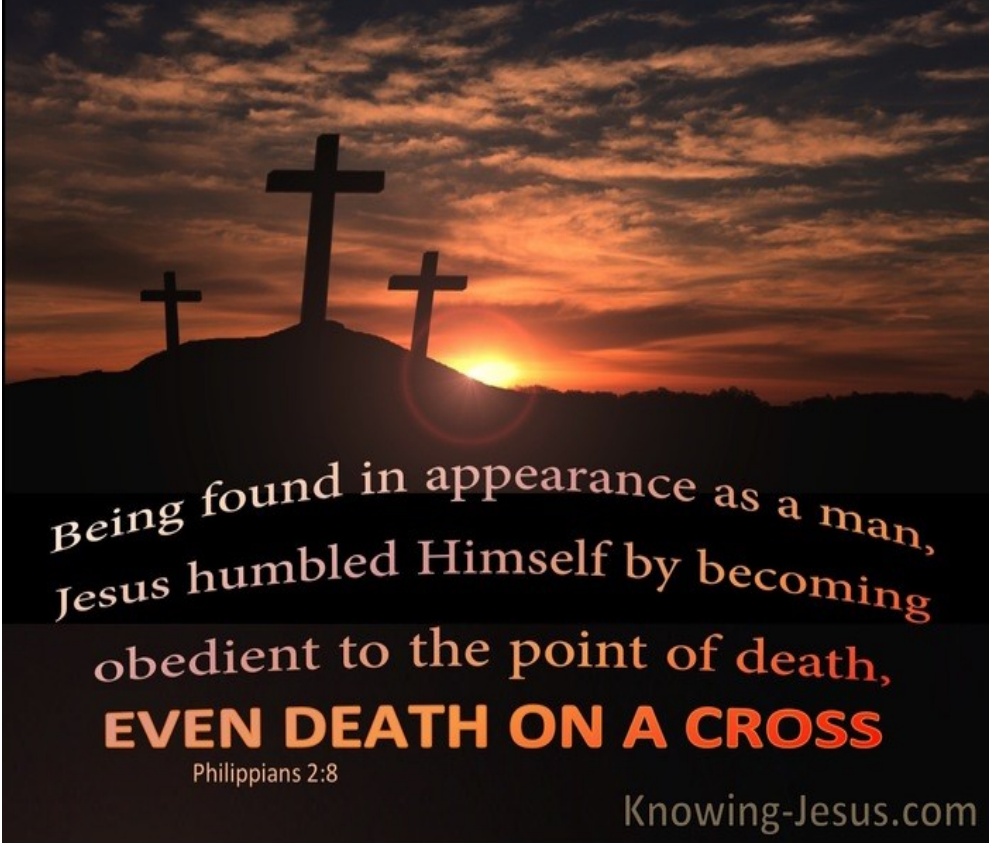

Passover Meal - 6:30pm Thursday March 28th at St Chad's

Our Passover Meal is an opportunity for the Church Family to gather to enter into the events of Jesus' last Passover Meal with his disciples on the night he was arrested. The meal will follow the traditional Jewish Passover Meal format but with a reinterpretation of those elements that are now part of the Communion Service. This is a wonderful way of entering into the events that began that first Easter. If you would like to attend this Passover Meal, please write your name on the list in the foyer before Tuesday March 26th. This year, we are having the meal catered for so the cost (for a roast lamb meal, with dessert) will be \$20 per person (\$10 for those under 15) or \$50 a family. You can put cash in the offering bowl in an envelope labelled with your name and "Passover" or you can deposit into our bank account and label this transaction "Passover". 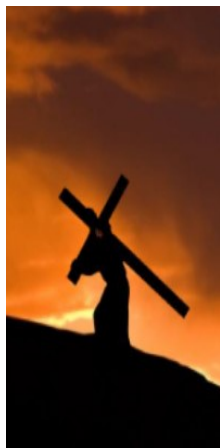
