Pantry 5000 Funding A letter from Councillor Cameron Howe

In 2021, Pantry 5000 was the City of Kingston's Community Group of the Year. However, the City of Kingston is now recommending cutting funding for the community's food bank service.

As part of this proposed action, 2024-25 will see a "staged funding reduction", with the 2024-25 year's total food bank funding being reduced to \$33,193 (down from \$37,289 in 2023-24) and the recommended total food bank funding being reduced to \$25,000 by 2027.

Pantry 5000 will be directly impacted by this proposed reduction in funding.

With the cost-of-living crisis, reducing funding for the city's food bank services doesn't make sense and will place additional stress on families, individuals and the volunteers who struggle to keep these services operating.

It is the wrong time, the wrong decision and wrong if every way. Councillors will vote at the public ordinary meeting on June 24.
