In July 2024 Matt's Place Chelsea will have been serving the community for 15 years. We are still serving hot, homestyle, delicious food and we are still a welcoming and warm place for people to come and meet friends and family. We recently had some social work students come to visit and they asked our guests what they loved about Matt's Place. Every single person replied, first and foremost, that they loved the community. This is a testament to the Matt's Place volunteers who treat everyone as a person of value—an image bearer of God. Matt's Place has an extraordinary team of volunteers. They all give sacrificially and no task is too difficult. After the disruption of Covid, handing out take away meals and intermittent returns to sit down dining for both Lunch Church and Matt's Place, we are back to open doors and sit down dining. We serve up to 60 -70 guests in the main hall and about 15 guests in Lunch Church. The shadow of Covid still lingers and many people are still reti-

cent to dine in. We prepare takeaway food for those who don't want to stay and this continues to be a popular option with about 20 people a week choosing to take food home. We will be having a big party on Tuesday July 30 to celebrate our 15 years, with all our regular guests, past and present volunteers and local dignitaries.
