Longbeach Anglican Vision Process

At our Parish Council meeting we have been discussing the mismatch we have between our resources and what we are trying to achieve. We can see this will only get more difficult as time goes on. In order to plan for this and make decisions to turn this around we would like your input. We'd appreciate any ideas you have or solutions to the shortage of resources including finances, people, time, staffing, volunteers and the properties.

We are starting a process to work out solutions and invite your input over the next few months (see the handout provided). Some helpful information regarding our properties is listed below as it has come to our attention that people are not aware of the properties we have.

All properties are owned by the Melbourne Diocese even though the members of the Church have paid for them and the upgrades over the years. Therefore, if we are to sell a property, it is at the discretion of the Diocese as to what funds are given to the Church that has a strong missional plan.

As a Church, we oversee 5 properties. They are:

- St Aidan's Church
- \cdot St Aidan's Vicarage (rented out, but managed by Ray White real estate)
- St Barnabas Church in Seaford (deconsecrated as an Anglican Church and rented by a Zimbabwean Congregation)
- St Chad's Church
- St Chad's Vicarage (used by the Vicar)

At St Barnabas, there are also four units that are maintained and managed by the Diocese who also receive the rental income.
