**Bible Reading: Ephesians 5.21-6.4 (Merylin W)**

<sup>21</sup> being subject to one another out of reverence for Christ.

<sup>22</sup> Wives, be subject<sup>[a]</sup> to your husbands as to the Lord, <sup>23</sup> for the husband is the head of the wife just as Christ is the head of the church, his body, and is himself its Savior. <sup>24</sup> Just as the church is subject to Christ, so also wives ought to be, in everything, to their husbands.

<sup>25</sup> Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her <sup>26</sup> in order to make her holy by cleansing her with the washing of water by the word, <sup>27</sup> so as to present the church to himself in splendor, without a spot or wrinkle or anything of the kind, so that she may be holy and without blemish. <sup>28</sup> In the same way, husbands should love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. <sup>29</sup> For no one ever hates his own flesh, but he nourishes and tenderly cares for it, just as Christ does for the church, <sup>30</sup> because we are members of his body.<sup>[b]</sup> <sup>31</sup> “For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two will become one flesh.” <sup>32</sup> This is a great mystery, but I am speaking about Christ and the church. <sup>33</sup> Each of you, however, should love his wife as himself, and a wife should respect<sup>[c]</sup> her husband.

**6** Children, obey your parents in the Lord,<sup>[d]</sup> for this is right. <sup>2</sup> “Honor your father and mother” —this is the first commandment with a promise— <sup>3</sup> “so that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth.”

<sup>4</sup> And, fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.
