SYNOD REPORT 2024

Synod was held a couple of weeks ago and there was a Special Synod held in June which also dealt with matters such as Safe Ministry, professional standards and the process of electing a new Archbishop.

Presentations included Hope 25 (a national movement starting from Easter 2025, sharing the hope we have in Jesus Christ in an uncertain world). disability, inclusion in church activities and accessibility, diversity and inclusion, safe ministry and leading your church into growth.

Legislation included an approval process for reductions in frequency of services, and amendments restricting the publication of certain information, largely relating to statistics and those holding clergy and lay authorisations, to the parish portal and not on a website available to the general public.

The Diocesan accounts and budget were presented. The Diocese reported a deficit of \$3.6m in 2023. A cash outflow of \$13m is projected for 2025. Property sales and the cost of redress of previous child abuse claims continue to be significant. The Finance Report includes a comment that the Diocese does not generate sufficient income from parishes or investments to cover its redress obligations or regular operational requirements, despite numerous and comprehensive reviews of the efficiency and effectiveness of Diocesan services and budget savings.

A Diocesan Sustainability Strategy Working Group has been set up to address concerns over church sustainability including matters such as finance, church property sales, the cost of redress claims, declining church attendance and population growth corridors in Melbourne.

Motions discussed included reconciliation, diversity and inclusion, disability inclusion and accessibility, healthcare chaplaincy, the possible removal of the minimum age of 18 for Parish Council and Synod membership, the code of conduct for child safety and wellbeing and a vote of thanks for the ministry of Archbishop Philip Freier.

A copy of the Church roll is at the back of both Churches. Could you please check that your name is on it and tick that the details are correct.


Annual Parish Meeting—November 17 Nominations for Office Bearers
