Advent Wreath

This week is the first Sunday of Advent, and we are reminded again of the hope that Christ's coming brings for everyone.

This year, the invitation comes to us again. It is an invitation to slow down, to relearn a pace of life that is unhurried so that we can focus on a life lived in God's light. This life is one filled with hope, peace, joy and love. Jesus encourages us to live in 'readiness' – always aware that Christ's coming is immanent and avoiding the temptation of growing absorbed in self-interest and personal pleasure.

Each year we light candles and the flame helps us find our way. In darkness we lose direction. We cannot see where we have been or where we are going. A single candle, flickering brightly, helps us find our way again. In God's Word the prophet Isaiah describes God as being the light of the world. "Arise, Jerusalem, and shine like the sun; The glory of the Lord is shining on you! Other nations will be covered by darkness, but on you the light of the Lord will shine; The brightness of his presence will be with you."

The first candle is lit.
