Advent 1

Every time I travel to New Zealand, my family always ask what time are you arriving and I can reasonably confidently say the appointed time. They do this so that they can plan for our arrival. Paul has a similar image for the "appointed time" for Christ's second coming— only on an infinitely grander scale—in 1 Thessalonians 4:16–17. When a Roman emperor or provincial governor arrived with great fanfare to visit a city, the civic dignitaries would go out for a meeting with him as he approached and accompany him into their city. Believers who are alive when the "appointed time" comes will do the same: we will meet and welcome Jesus back, forever, as the returning king of His eternal new creation.

That is the glorious Advent hope which fills our hearts and worship in these weeks before we celebrate Christ's first coming. And its "appointed time" is known only to God; we are not to waste time guessing its ETA but to be prepared at all times. And there will be no flight delays, strikes, or bad weather! But it is the second "appointed time."

During advent, God invites us to slow down, to relearn a pace of life that is unhurried so that we can focus on a life lived in God's light. This life is one filled with hope, peace, joy and love. Jesus encourages us to live in 'readiness' – always aware that Christ's coming is immanent and avoiding the temptation of growing absorbed in self-interest and personal pleasure. This week let's celebrate and open ourselves to the power of God's gift of hope in Christ.
