Decisions at Wardens and Parish Council

Over the last few years, there have been incidents at Pantry 5000 and Matt's Place that have made the Parish Council reassess having children and youth at our Outreach Programs. After much discussion, we have made a policy that as a Church we will NOT have volunteers under 18 at any of our weekly outreach programs. Some of the guests who come to our programs have major struggles with life in general and do not always act in a safe manner, and youth are not necessarily equipped to handle this. Governance and Operations in our ministries

Over the past few years, there has been some confusion as to who is responsible for making decisions regarding both governance and operations. After considerable discussion at the Wardens and Parish Council meetings and discussion with Professional Standards, it was felt that we needed to make this clearer to the Church.

1. The Vicar and the Parish Council (Board) are responsible for Governance.

The Vicar of the Parish is in charge of all ministries and the Parish Council (Board) are the ones who make sure that the ministry runs in accordance with the law and the standards of the Anglican Church.

2. The Vicar and key leader or volunteers of program(s) are responsible for Day to Day Operations. The key leaders are responsible to the Vicar and the Board.

The Vicar and Board oversee all governance related issues including: vision; mission and strategy; policies; risk; property; finance; culture; reputation; duty of care; and the approving of volunteers; etc. The Vicar and the leadership teams oversee how the ministry functions, how it is promoted and small financial matters.

Some issues affect both the Vicar and the Board (Governance), and the Leadership Team (Operations), and will be discussed collaboratively between the teams.
