Thank you everyone for your patience during my time as treasurer. I know many of you have been hoping for pew sheet financial reports. Now that we are using Xero for our accounting, this has made this part of my job much easier. My expectation is that now I will be able to provide information each month about the parish's financial position. Our month tracked well against our budget. However when we look at the year to date results (\$12670 deficit), our biggest shortfall is in giving. This is having an over \$14000 negative effect on our finances to the end of March. Another lost income for the year is the rental from St Barnabus. Parish Council is researching the best way to restore this income source.

Thank you to everyone who increased their giving the last few months. In order for us to continue to operate the parish with all the Christian goodwill we can, we appreciate the financial support you can provide.
