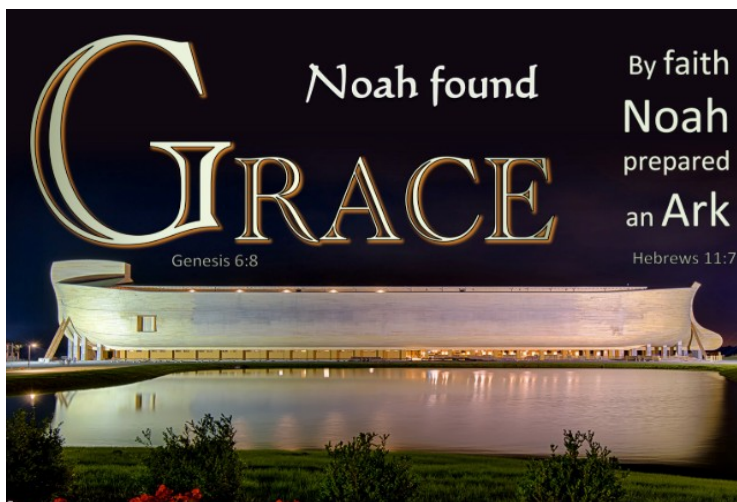

Genesis 6

Genesis chapter 5 began with the 'generations of Adam,' Chapter 6 verse 9 begins with the account of Noah and his family. However, the chapter doesn't launch into a list of Noah's descendants, instead, it tells us about Noah and his character. We're told he is both righteous and blameless among the people of his time. Noah was righteous in the sense that he did was right, and he was blameless in the sense that he didn't do what was wrong. Noah's choices stood in contrast, to the sinful, selfish choices of the rest of humanity. He was a moral, god-honouring man. More than that, we're told that Noah walked with God. Walking with God, involves not only knowing but also obeying God's commands and following the path He has set for us. It's a personal relationship with God, where we actively seek to know Him better, trust Him more and be in communion with Him. It involves resetting our thoughts, words and actions to God's character and values.

Winter Warmers Update

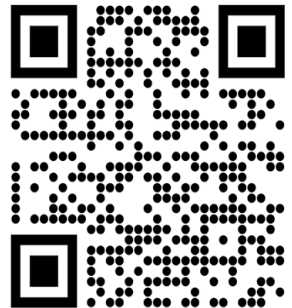
