Baptisms

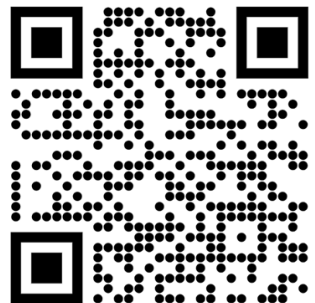
