## **Genesis 8**

Chapter 8 opens with the words 'God remembered Noah'. God also remembered the animals. He would fulfil His promise to keep them safe and begin creation over again, on a world made new by the flood. After 150 days, the ark came to rest on the mountains of Ararat. Still, Noah waited to hear from God that it was time to leave the ark. Nearly two months later, God gave Noah the command to leave, along with his family and every living thing aboard. After a full year on the ark of their salvation, they disembarked to begin again. Noah's first action after leaving is to build an altar to God, the first recorded altar in scripture. On it Noah offered sacrifices to God and we're told that God was pleased. He makes a commitment to never again cause a flood to wipe out all the living creatures, even though He recognizes that humanity will continue to carry evil intentions in their heart. 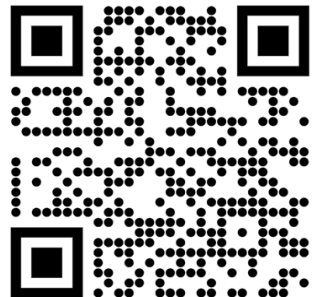
## **MOJO Concert**
