<sup>8</sup>Do not rejoice over me, my enemies;<sup>[d]</sup>

when I fall, I shall rise;

when I sit in darkness,

the LORD will be a light to me.

<sup>9</sup>I must bear the indignation of the LORD

because I have sinned against him,

until he takes my side

and executes judgment for me.

He will bring me out to the light;

I shall see his vindication.  
10 Then my enemies<sup>[e]</sup> will see,  
and shame will cover those<sup>[f]</sup> who said to me,  
“Where is the LORD your God?”

16 The nations shall see and be ashamed  
of all their might;  
they shall lay their hands on their mouths;  
their ears shall be deaf;  
17 they shall lick dust like a snake,  
like the crawling things of the earth;  
they shall come trembling out of their fortresses;  
they shall turn in dread to the LORD our God,  
and they shall stand in fear of you.  
18 Who is a God like you, pardoning iniquity  
and passing over the transgression  
of the remnant of his possession?  
He does not retain his anger forever  
because he delights in showing steadfast love.  
19 He will again have compassion upon us;

he will tread our iniquities under foot.  
You will cast all our<sup>□</sup> sins  
into the depths of the sea.
