Lent starts on 18 February, and we recommend using some helpful devotional aids as you spend time with God during this time.

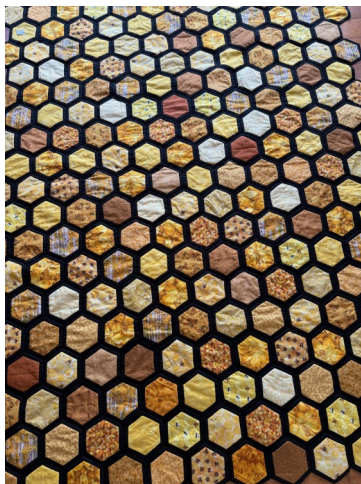
